Thomas A. Paton Scholarship Award Philadelphia Chapter of AAHAM

- **Purpose**: To provide educational scholarships to individual AAHAM members and their children or grandchildren.
- **Eligibility:** Any person who has been a Philadelphia AAHAM and National AAHAM member for at least one year and has paid their current dues by June 30 of the year in which application is made. If a member's child is applying, the above eligibility criteria apply to the child's parent.
- Application: Formal application to the Philadelphia AAHAM Awards Chair by August 30.
- Selection: Applications that meet the established criteria will be considered by a review and selection committee comprised of the Board Members of the Philadelphia Chapter of AAHAM.
- Awards: Scholarships will be awarded (as funds permit) in June as follows: One year awards:
 - \$1,000 Philadelphia Chapter Member Award
 - \$1,000 Child of Philadelphia Chapter Member Award

The Philadelphia AAHAM Scholarship Program provides for two classifications of awards. Classification of awards is as follows:

- 1. Member scholarship award:
 - a. Member must have been a National and Local member of Philadelphia AAHAM for at least one year and be a current member as of June 30 of the application year
 - b. Maximum Amount of award is \$1,000 per year which shall be less than or equal to the cost of tuition and related expenses No more than one (1) award shall be given per year for this program.
- 2. Child of a member scholarship award:
 - a. Must be a child or grandchild of a current Philadelphia and National AAHAM member for at leas one year.
 - b. Maximum amount of award is \$1,000 per year which shall be less than or equal to the cost tuition and related educational expenses. No more than one (1) award shall be given per year for this program.

Application requirements and procedure:

Member applicant (application below)

- 1. The member must be a current (paid) Philadelphia AAHAM and National AAHAM member on June 30th of the year in which application for scholarship is made.
- 2. The member must have been a (paid) Philadelphia and National AAHAM member for at least one year prior to the application deadline of May 31.
- A completed and typed application form, including all attachments specified in the application, must be submitted to AAHAM's Philadelphia Board Members by May 31. Applications, which are postmarked no later than May 31, shall be accepted for consideration.
- 4. The applicant must also submit, by May 31, a letter of acceptance from the educational institution or a statement from the registrar indicating enrollment.

Child of member applicant (application below)

- 1. The member must be a current (paid) Philadelphia AAHAM and National AAHAM member on June 30th of the year in which application for scholarship is made.
- 2. The member must have been a (paid) Philadelphia and National AAHAM member for at least one year prior to the application deadline of May 31.
- A completed and typed application form, including all attachments specified in the application, must be submitted to AAHAM's Philadelphia Board Members by May 31.
 Applications, which are postmarked no later than May 31, shall be accepted for consideration.
- 4. The applicant must also submit, by May 31, a letter of acceptance from the educational institution or a statement from the registrar indicating enrollment.

Selection

- 1. Criteria
 - a. Preference will be given to applicants enrolled in studies leading to a certificate or degree in health care or an associated field.
 - b. Selection will also be based on a review of the application and supporting documents.
 - c. No preference should be accorded an applicant by reason of the applicant employment position, job title or length of employment.
- 2. Applications will be screened by AAHAM's Philadelphia Board Members.
- 3. The review and selection committee will review the accepted applications and select the award recipients. This selection shall take place on or about .lune 15
- 4. Award recipients will be notified on or about June 15. Awards will be presented on or about June 15.

Compliance

- Member awardees must submit to AAHAM's Philadelphia Board proof of successful
 completion (passing grade) of a minimum of six semester hours of academic credit in an
 accredited college or university subsequent to receipt of the scholarship award and
 within one year of the date on which the award is received by the member. This should
 be in the form of an official transcript of grades and credits earned from the educational
 institution.
- Child of a Member awardees must submit to AAHAM's Philadelphia Board proof of successful completion (passing grade) of academic course of study for the academic period in an accredited college or university subsequent to receipt of the scholarship award and within one year of the date on which the award is received by the member. This should be in the form of an official transcript of grades and credits earned from the educational institution.
